## John Paul Lederach

Senior Fellow at Humanity United and Professor Emeritus of International Peacebuilding at the Joan B. Kroc Institute for International Peace Studies at the University of Notre Dame. Dr. Lederach received his bachelor's degree in history and peace studies from Bethel College and his doctorate of philosophy degree in sociology, with a concentration on social conflict, from the University of Colorado.

Dr. Lederach is internationally recognized for his pioneering work in the field of conciliation and conflict mediation. He has provided consultation for peacebuilding efforts in Somalia, Northern Ireland, Colombia, the Basque Country, the Philippines, Tajikistan, Nepal and in East and West Africa. John Paul is widely known for the development of culturally appropriate approaches to conflict transformation and the design and implementation of integrative and strategic approaches to peacebuilding and helped lead hundreds of training programs in conflict transformation, mediation and international peacebuilding in 35 countries around the world. He served as the director of the Peace Accord Matrix research initiative at the Kroc Institute and is active as a member of the Advisory Council for the recently formed Truth Commission in Colombia.

He is author and editor of 24 books and manuals, including *Building Peace: Sustainable Reconciliation in Divided Societies (*US Institute of Peace Press) and *The Moral Imagination: The Art and Soul of Building Peace* (Oxford University Press).
